





Miss Miller is very impressed by how well Shetland clan have been using cuisinaire rods to explore addition and subtraction. There was lots of great concentration and determination shown here!











Primary 2 Skye clan have been learning all about how animals react to the change in season and winter, they made bird feeders to ensure the birds had enough food to eat over winter!












Linlithgow








Tummel


