Use the choices below to decide what home learning tasks you would like your child to take part in. It is up to families as to how many activities they complete.



My weekly reading homework is to choose a personal reader. I can select this book from my clan library, online books or books from my home. When I complete a book I will update my reading

<p>Task 1 <u>Place value</u></p> <p>Click me</p> <p>to find questions relating to place value and position of numbers.</p>	<p>Task 4 <u>Challenge</u></p> <p>Can you find your favourite book and rewrite the blurb in Scots? Post it on Teams to see if the clan can read it!</p>	<p>Task 7 <u>Ceilidh dancing</u></p> <p>This term we are learning and practicing Ceilidh dancing – why not try teaching someone else a dance you have learned at school?</p>	<p>Task 10 <u>Talk to someone Scottish!</u></p> <p>Find a friend or relative who is Scottish and see what you can find out about Scotland, whether its interesting facts, history, geography, or really anything!</p>
<p>Task 2 <u>Sumdog</u></p> <p>Login to Sumdog and try some of their numeracy questions!</p> 	<p>Task 5 <u>Poems</u></p> <p>Can you create a limerick poem about Scotland? It could be about a historical figure, the culture or anything! Remember – AABBA, 8,8,5,5,8!</p>	<p>Task 8 <u>Creative</u></p> <p>Can you create your own Ceilidh dance! You may want to do some research by watching videos of other Ceilidh dances.</p>	<p>Task 11 <u>Europe challenge</u></p> <p>Can you remember all 44 European countries in alphabetical order?</p> <p>Try and create a song or poster to help you remember!</p>
<p>Task 3 <u>Cook for the clan!</u></p> <p>Can you find a recipe and see if you can scale up the ingredients measurement to feed your clan!</p> <p>e.g. if a recipe feeds 4 people, you may need to times the ingredients by 7. Does the measurement still make sense, or would it be better to use a different measurement, e.g. change grams to kilograms if you are feeding 32?</p>	<p>Task 6 <u>For the love of cooking!</u></p> <p>Find a cook book and browse through the recipes - Look at the structure and how the style of writing. Try rewriting the recipe or creating a whole new one! With an adult, you could try and cook it!</p>	<p>Task 9 <u>Research</u></p> <p>Can you find out some of the skills involved in Badminton in preparation for our upcoming P.E. topic?</p> <p>Can you practice the movements for some of these skills?</p>	<p>Task 12 <u>French and Spanish</u></p> <p>Using information learned in the clan, or from your own research – create something to show what you know about French and/or Spanish culture (a poster, video, podcast, scratch or anything else.</p>
