



P5-P7 Clans: Home Learning Overview

How will the grids be created?

Our grids will be co-constructed with the pupils, where they will share what learning opportunities/skills they would like to have at home. Champions and pupils will create the grids together during every 4 weekly block. The grids will be an opportunity to extend learning from the classroom at home, practice skills and learning concepts, and an opportunity for self-directed learning.

Grid expectations

- Our grids will last for a duration of 4 weeks.
- There will be a combination of mandatory and optional tasks: mandatory tasks will be highlighted in light blue.
 - The grid will be a combination of literacy, numeracy/maths, health and wellbeing and across the curriculum learning opportunities.
- Sumdog and Lanuagenut can be accessed by the pupil's individual username and password.
- Spelling will feature as a task on our grids. This will focus on topic words and important vocabulary used across the curriculum.
- Reading for enjoyment is encouraged at least 3 times a week. Pupils can use their First Ministers reading passport to record their reading journey.

Feedback

- Feedback will be a combination of teacher feedback and self/peer assessment.
- Feedback from the champion will be given in their class notebook in two different ways: written feedback in a different colour or an audio voice note.
- Pupils will also get the chance to peer and self-assess their home learning in class.

Accessing/uploading home learning

- The home learning grids will be shared on teams.
- All pupils will record their home learning on: Teams-Class Notebook- Home Learning Jotter
- Pupils can add photographs, upload videos, add links to a PPT/Sway or type directly onto their home learning jotter.
