Step 2- Carry out research and write your own notes. Remember to present your notes in a way that makes sense to you. For example, you may choose to carry out a mind map, use bullet points or make a detailed poster. Step 3- Write an information report using your notes.</p>	<p>Task 4</p> <p>Science</p> <p>Make a 3D model of a plant out of different resources materials such as playdough, Lego and cardboard.</p> <p>Label the different parts of a plant on your model.</p> <p>Take a photo and share on teams!</p>
