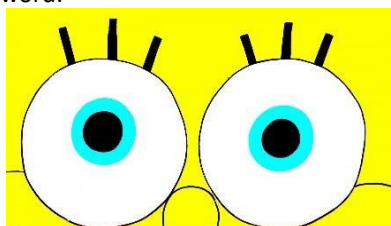
Task 1

Can you make a kindness flower for someone in your family or a friend? Write their name in the middle and then write a kind word to describe them on each of the petals. This would make a lovely gift.
