<p><b>Task 1</b></p> <p>Create your own hopscotch grid outside using a number sequence of your choice. This could be 2s, 5s, 10s or any sequence that challenges you.</p>	<p><b>Task 4</b></p> <p>1. What nouns can you find around your house or in your local area? 2. What adjectives can you use to describe the nouns you have found? 3. Get an adult or a friend to name some verbs. Can you complete the actions?</p>	<p><b>Task 7</b></p> <p>Speak to your adults at home about what makes a trusted adult. Can you identify some trusted adults at home, school and in the community?</p>	<p><b>Task 9</b></p> <p>Go on a walk around your local area or somewhere new! What can you find that helps with direction? Give directions to a family member or friend using directional language.</p>
<p><b>Task 2</b></p> <p>Create your own concrete materials to show place value. Choose a different material to represent ones, tens and hundreds (or beyond!) Use your concrete materials to partition different numbers.</p>	<p><b>Task 5</b></p> <p>What texts can you find around your home? Sort them into fiction and non-fiction. What features helped you to figure this out?</p>	<p><b>Task 8</b></p> <p>Speak to an adult about the medicine kept in your house. Find out where it is kept and why it is important to keep it there.</p>	<p><b>Task 10</b></p> <p>Create a map of your local area. Label any important landmarks.</p>
<p><b>Task 3</b></p> <p>Play the place value games on Topmarks:</p> <p><a href="#">Basketball</a> <a href="#">Place value charts</a> <a href="#">Odd or even</a></p>	<p><b>Task 6</b></p> <p>Choose a new book. Use the front cover and blurb to make a prediction about what will happen in the text. Remember to explain what clues you have used!</p>	<p><b>Sumdog</b></p> <p>Complete the Sumdog numeracy challenge you have been set.</p>	<p><b>French</b></p> <p>Practise counting to 30 in French. If you feel confident, try counting backwards or skip counting in 2s or 5s.</p>
