Calderwood Construction:

- ✓ We are pleased to inform you that the contractor has installed Heras fencing around the perimeter of the football pitch, field and up to the MUGA. This will now restrict public access to these areas and will ensure that our children are able to use these areas for their P.E. lessons and for play.
- ✓ Hoarding boards have been erected around the building site and Heras fencing has been removed. This has allowed us to return to some of our daily routines and has given us some additional playground back.
- ✓ We are delighted to share that Morrison Construction have informed us that the foundations for our new classrooms will be poured on **Wednesday, 1st November**. Whilst this is very exciting, it will require continual vehicular access throughout the day in order to complete the process. We ask that you are mindful of this exercise when dropping your children off in the morning and collecting them at the end of their day.
- ✓ During the week beginning Monday, **6th November** Morrison Construction have advised that the steel frame for the new extension will be delivered. This exercise will take two weeks and will involve cranes, working within the building site, to support the frame being erected. This will be another exciting phase in the construction process and we know the children will be very excited to see the frame of the extension taking shape so quickly.
- ✓ A gentle reminder to families that there is no parking on the Nethershiel Road side of the school. Please note that our staff finish their shifts at different times during the course of the day, we would ask if you are using the car park that you park responsibly.
- ✓ We thank you for your support at this time and want to reassure you that we are assessing our routines on a daily basis to ensure the safety of all.
