This year we received approximately £49,000 Pupil Equity Funding (PEF) which will be used for staffing, resources and wider experiences to target attainment and achievement across the following áreas:

- Assessment using a resource called SEAL with identified learners to identify gaps in learning and ensure progress.

Work with families to increase attendance at school.

Football Buzz sessions with pupils across P3-7 to develop confidence, team work, resilience and wellbeing.

Parent council support (Halloween swap shop, supporting cost of the school day with financial support for trips and events.

A focused approach to improving attendance for targeted pupils

Life skills and alternative curriculum for those learners who require a unique way to learn.
