<p><b>Task 1</b></p> <p>Practise writing out number sentences for subtraction. You can use playing or uno cards to help you.</p>	<p><b>Task 4</b></p> <p>Read your reading book and predict what might happen after the book finishes. Upload a voice recording or a short story explaining this!</p>	<p><b>Task 7</b></p> <p>Complete the Shale Trail challenge which was set out on Seesaw by your Clan Champion.</p>	<p><b>Task 10</b></p> <p>Practise clan talk in front of someone at home. Think about what you need to remember when speaking to an audience: eye contact, notes/pictures, speak clearly/loudly.</p>
<p><b>Task 2</b></p> <p>Counting collections. Go for a walk and collect natural items e.g. sticks, stones. Make a number sentence to show subtraction. Remember to start with the largest number first.</p>	<p><b>Task 5</b></p> <p>Write down as many Scottish words that you know and write a short story using each word. Ask an adult to help with Scottish words!</p>	<p><b>Task 8</b></p> <p>Children worked in coal mines alongside adults, how would you feel if you had to work in a coal mine? Imagine working in a dark, cold mine having to lift heavy bits of coal – how would that make you feel? Record a quick voice note with your thoughts.</p>	<p><b>Task 11</b></p> <p>Design your very own Scottish drink or sweet treat. Draw a picture of this and describe what this would look like or taste like.</p>
<p><b>Task 3</b></p> <p>Shape pictures. Using different things around the house that are different shapes and sizes create a unique picture with them. Remember to take a picture and post it in seesaw.</p>	<p><b>Task 6</b></p> <p>Narrative Writing – Draw a character and use adjectives to describe your character. Can you think of a problem your character might face and then provide a solution to solve their problem.</p>	<p><b>Task 9</b></p> <p>Scottish Country Dancing – ask an adult, sibling or friend to practise some of the steps you have been learning during PE. Upload a video to Seesaw or demonstrate in class!</p>	<p><b>Task 12</b></p> <p>Have a look on the Steven Brown website <a href="https://www.stevenbrownart.co.uk">https://www.stevenbrownart.co.uk</a> Draw a different animal using his iconic colourful art style. Remember to use lots of different lengths and thickness of lines.</p>
