My weekly reading homework is to read for enjoyment for 10 minutes each evening. Looking for opportunities to read text in real life.

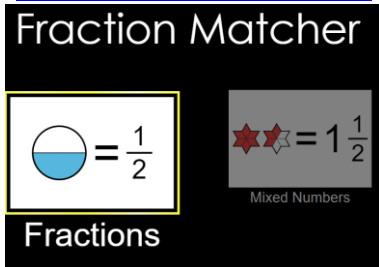

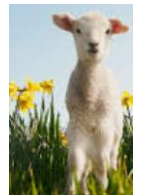
Task 4
