Our vision at Calderwood Primary is that all pupils, regardless of circumstance, have the opportunities and support they need to go “Beyond the Dream”. This year, we received approximately £49,000 through the Pupil Equity Fund (PEF). This will be used for staffing, resources and wider experiences to target attainment and achievement across the following areas:

Health and Wellbeing

- Personalised support packages based on individual needs, including use of a dedicated regulation space.
- Regulation and Wellbeing groups for identified learners, to develop emotional literacy, and confidence and engagement in school.
- Wellbeing Breakfast for identified learners, to increase attendance and readiness to learn.
- Continuation of wider community experiences, including Social Enterprise and community partnership with ‘The Hub’ in East Calder, to ensure opportunities for all learners to experience success and develop skills.
- Football Buzz sessions with pupils across P3, P4 and P5 to develop confidence, team work, resilience and wellbeing.

Literacy

Improving Literacy Outcomes for learners

- Targeted Writing support for identified learners to increase achievement of Core Writing Targets and raise attainment.

Learner Participation and Engagement

- Family Link Worker for 1 day a week.
- 3x Pupil Support Workers with a dedicated focus on helping to raise attainment and achievement with identified learners.
- Work with families to increase attendance at school of children below 90%.
- Continuation of wider community experiences, including Social Enterprise and community partnership with ‘The Hub’ in East Calder, to ensure opportunities for all learners to experience success and develop skills.
- Continued Parent Council support (Halloween swap shop, supporting cost of the school day with financial support for trips and events.)
- Life skills and alternative curriculum for those learners who require a unique way to learn.
- Continue to develop our Sustainability Station within the school and nursery to provide food, clothing, advice/support to our families.
