# **English & Literacy**

# Listening and Talking

In Term 1, we will be learning about a range of presentational skills to support us to create and deliver our own solo talk. Our presentation will be linked to our interdisciplinary topic of F1 racing. We will be exploring the skills of:

- Making eye contact
- Using body language
- Using appropriate pace, tone, volume and expression in our voice
- Asking and answering questions confidently

- Using props and resources to support our presentations

#### Writing

In Term 1, we will be consolidating the following core targets in our writing:

- Capital letters and full stops
- Use of finger spaces
- Use of connectives
- Using tricky words

This term, our genre focus will be description writing. We will be learning how to:

- Use adjectives to describe an object/person
- Use action verbs in our writing
- Including a title and introduction
- Use the description bubble

In handwriting, we will be focusing on forming lowercase and uppercase letters confidently and using this in our writing.

- Developing fluency and expression when reading

# **Numeracy**
