<p>Task 1</p> <p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Identify who the main character is in your book and create a character description about them.</p> <p>Tips to help – adjectives, up-levelling words.</p>	<p>Task 2</p> <p><u>Numeracy</u></p> <p>Ask a family member to write down different random numbers. See how many numbers you can create using these digits. You must be able to identify and read the number out loud.</p> <p>Mild – ask for 4-5 numbers Hot – 6-7 numbers Spicy – 8-9 numbers</p> <p>Challenge – once you have created different numbers, order them from smallest to biggest</p>	<p>Task 3</p> <p><u>Physical Activity</u></p> <p>Practise building up your fitness and stamina.</p> <p>How many jumping jacks can you do in a row before you get tired?</p> <p>How many burpees can you do in a row before you get tired?</p> <p>How many knee tuck jumps can you do in a row before you get tired?</p>	<p>Task 4</p> <p><u>IDL</u></p> <p>Design a School uniform and create a price list for each item. Aim to be realistic with your pricing. (think about our research on the cost of uniforms)</p>
<p>Task 5</p> <p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Read the next chapter of your book. Create a summary based on the main events in the chapter.</p> <p>Tips to help- Beginning, middle and end strategy.</p> <p>What happened at the beginning? What happened in the middle? What happened at the end?</p>	<p>Task 6</p> <p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>You have a budget of £18, what could you buy from the shop? Create a list.</p> <p>Bananas - £3.25 Apples - £2.75 Strawberries - £6.40 Potatoes - £3.79 Carrots - £2.10 Milk - £4.89</p>	<p>Task 7</p> <p><u>Positive Friendships</u></p> <p>Create a mind map describing what a positive friendship -</p> <p>Looks like Sounds like Feels like</p>	<p>Task 8</p> <p><u>IDL</u></p> <p>Create a poster about equity.</p> <p>Things to consider in your poster-</p> <p>What is equity?
