Remember to think about your use of voice and movement. Could you add expression or hand gestures? Practise with your family or in the mirror.</p>	<p><u>Task 3</u></p> <p>How many of each of these can you do in 1 minute: Star jumps, Burpees and Push ups. Can you try this every day and beat your score? Record your results.</p>	<p><u>Task 9</u></p> <p>A Scottish clan crest is a small symbol that represents a family group, or "clan," from Scotland. It often has a shield, an animal like a lion or deer, and a motto (a short saying) to show strength, bravery, or loyalty. Can you create your own family crest and shield?</p>
<p><u>Task 5</u></p> <p>Make a budget for a shopping trip or family event. Can you add up everything purchased and check you have enough money to pay for things?</p>	<p><u>Task 6</u></p> <p>Practise the next 100 Fry’s Words by using fancy fonts. Write or type the word normally, then write it in a fancy way.</p>	<p><u>Task 7</u></p> <p>What would you like to be when you grow up? Consider the skills you need to do this job and give examples. If you aren’t sure, why don’t you explore one of the jobs in our school? Teacher, janitor, cleaner, office champions, dinner ladies etc.</p>	<p><u>Task 8</u></p> <p>This term we will be looking at bravery and resilience. For three days write down something you’ve found tough, your unhelpful thought and what you did to overcome this thought.</p>
<p><u>Task 9</u> <u>Sumdog</u></p> <p>Complete the ‘Term 3 Addition & Subtraction’ challenge on Sumdog.</p>		<p><u>Task 10</u></p> <p>Practise your reading fluency and expression by reading a book to a family member.
