Road Safety:

- Park Smart Banners: Our banners are now finalised and we are awaiting these being printed. We look forward to receiving these and displaying them outside the school as soon as they are ready.
- SLT met with the Roads Department this week and we are delighted to share the following updates with you:
- A school warning sign is to be installed on the approach to the school building on Nethershiel Road
- The footpath adjacent to school is to be final surfaced with tactile paviours at crossing points
- A footpath is to be formed along Nethershiel Lane to the overflow carpark
- An additional crossing point is to be installed (half way along the school elevation at build out Nethershiel Road)
- Landscaping is to be applied to the corner to create a clear line of delineation.

The developer is doing his best to target the Easter Break for these works, but this will be dependant on tender and appointment of a suitable contractor.
