
Term 3

Task 3 Create a poster promoting kindness, inclusion and understanding within communities. Use slogans and visuals.	Task 4 Design a PE skills exercise programme developing tennis skills (movement, control, rallying). Show progression steps and try your programme out with someone at home.
Task 5 Create a fact file about an issue raised in Divided City (identity, friendship, belonging).
