Preschool Transition into P1

(Literacy Programme)

We are working with P1 staff to facilitate opportunities for the nursery preschoolers to come into the school in a small group and be a part of P1 Storytime. This part of our transition currently happens on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays weekly. Preschool pupils are with a familiar adult from nursery and are in the school for a short amount of time. The P1 Champions reading the story are not necessarily the champion who will be teaching P1 next year but gives our children the chance to sit in a P1 classroom and experience a story time and get a feel for school. The groupings that the preschoolers are in does not reflect their clan for P1, groups are based of child's day and session they attend.
