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| <p><b>Task 1</b></p> <p>Using your knowledge about Recounts gained this term, create a recount about a memory of your choice.</p> <p>Remember to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Title</li> <li>- Orientation</li> <li>- Sequence of Events</li> <li>- Personal Comment</li> </ul>                                  | <p><b>Task 2</b></p> <p>Create a personal "S1 Starter Pack" that shows what skills, strengths, and information you'll take with you to high school — and what you want to work on before you get there. Watch the <a href="#">student videos</a> (orange background) to help you.</p> | <p><b>Task 3</b></p> <p>Write five qualities that you think are important in a positive relationship. E.g. Kindness, Trust, Respect etc.</p> <p>Create a leaflet explaining why each of these qualities are important.</p>   | <p><b>Task 4</b></p> <p>Complete 3 mini athletics events at home, record your results, and reflect on your performance. You can do this indoors or outdoors as long as it's safe and you have enough space. Example events: Speed run, target throw, standing long jump.</p>  |
| <p><b>Task 5</b></p> <p>Collect data from people in your household and present your findings using at least two different types of graphs or charts.</p> <p>Make sure your graphs include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A title</li> <li>• Labelled axes</li> <li>• Clear categories</li> <li>• Accurate scale</li> </ul> | <p><b>Task 6</b></p> <p>Create a piece of artwork that represents your journey through primary school. Use any materials you have at home — pencils, pens, paint, collage, digital tools, or mixed media.</p>   | <p><b>Task 7</b></p> <p>Find three containers (e.g., cup, jug, bottle, bowl). Your task:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-<b>Estimate</b> how much water each container can hold (in millilitres or litres)</li> <li>-<b>Test</b> your estimate by filling it using a measuring jug or by counting how many cups it takes to fill it</li> <li>-<b>Record</b> your results</li> </ul> <p>E.g.<br/> <i>"I estimated the bowl would hold 800 ml. It actually held 950 ml."</i></p> | <p><b>Task 8</b></p> <p>Choose a character from your class novel or personal reading book. Create a character profile including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Full name</li> <li>• Picture</li> <li>• Role in the story</li> <li>• 3 words to describe them</li> <li>• Any interesting facts</li> </ul> |
| <p><b>Task 9-Sumdog</b></p> <p>Complete the challenges on Sumdog:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Data Handling Challenge</li> <li>• Multiplication Tables Practise</li> </ul>   |   | <p><b>Task 10-Languagenut</b></p> <p>Complete the challenges on Languagenut:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Spanish Environment Vocabulary</li> <li>• Spanish Technology Vocabulary</li> </ul>   |   |
