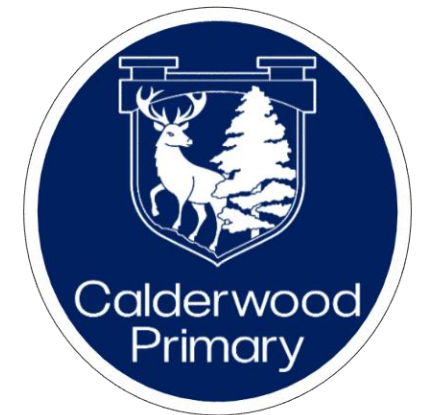


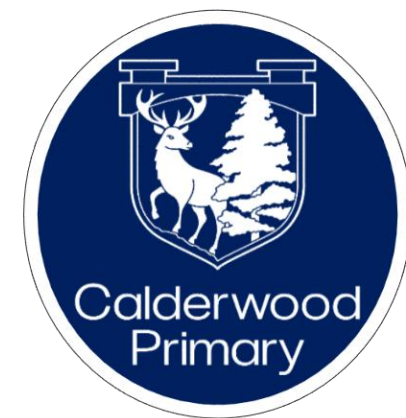
# Starting School – Bramble Clan



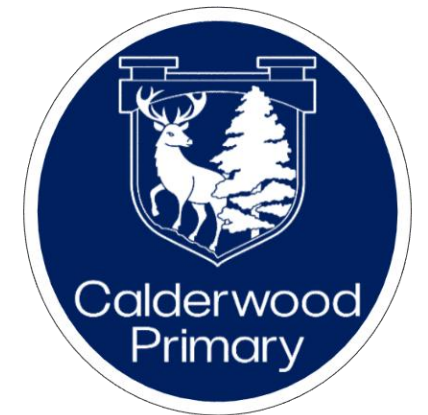
After the summer holidays, I will be starting Primary 1 at Calderwood Primary School.



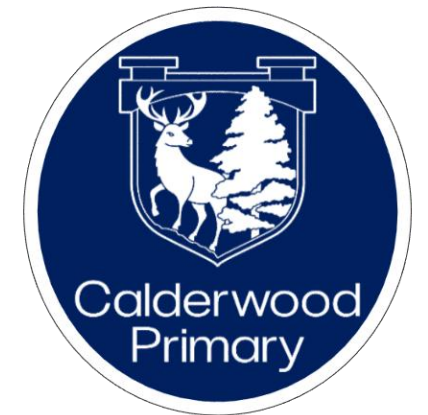
I will be in Bramble Clan (Primary 2/1).  
My teacher is called Ms Melrose and this is what she looks like.



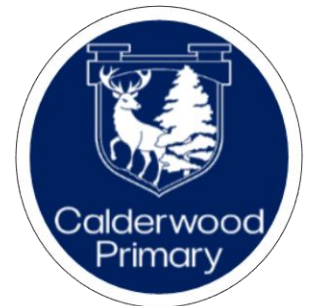
This is the door I will enter and where I will line up.



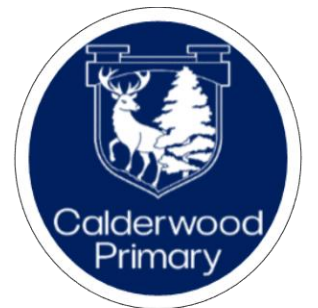
I will have a peg to hang my coat on.  
It will probably have my name on it.



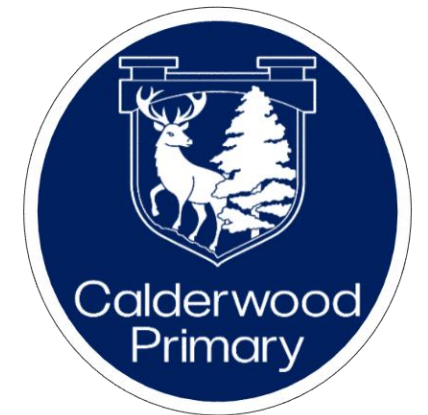
This will be my Bramble Clan room.



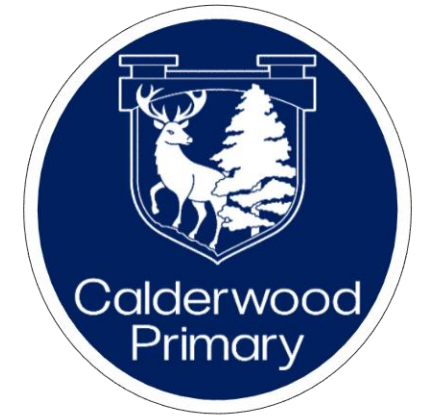
There are break out spaces for learning and quiet time.



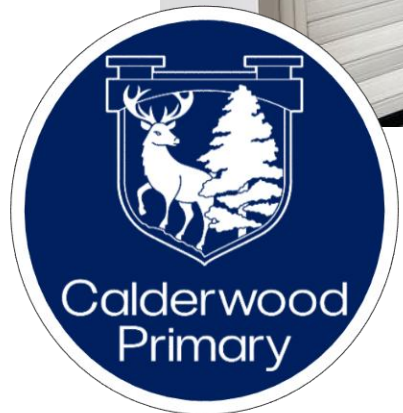
These are the toilets I will use.



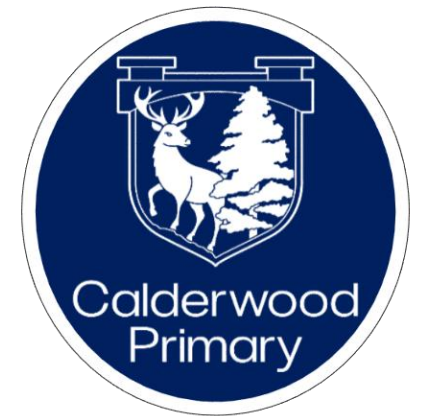
Most days I will probably go out to play. This is called playtime or break.



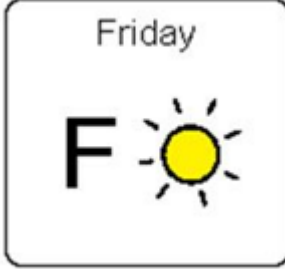
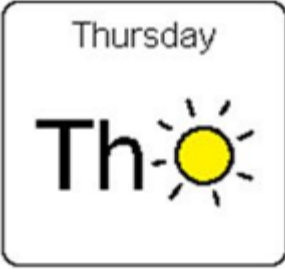
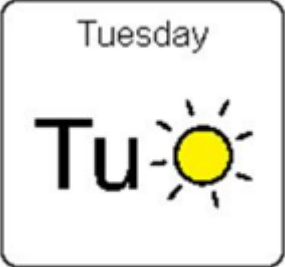
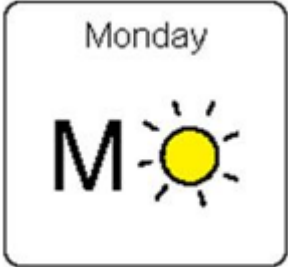
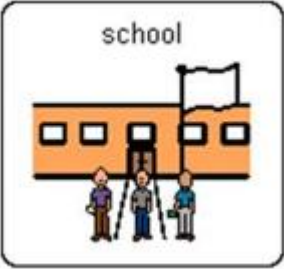
At lunchtime I will eat my lunch in the café.



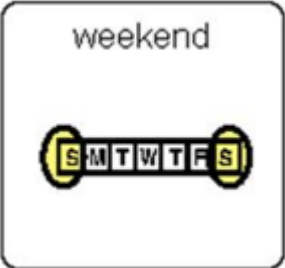
I will have indoor PE in the Arena on PE days.



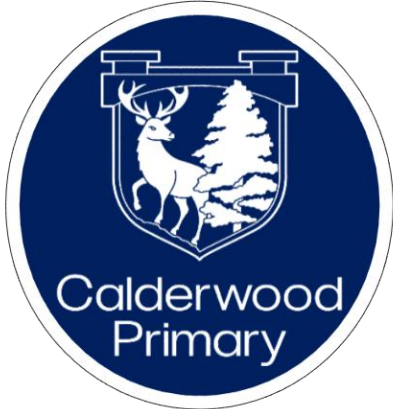
I will usually go to school on Mondays, Tuesday, Wednesdays, Thursdays, Fridays



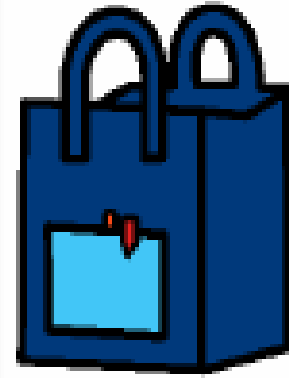
I will usually be at home on the weekend – Saturday and Sunday



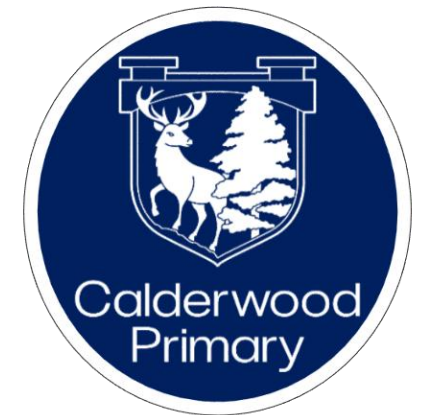
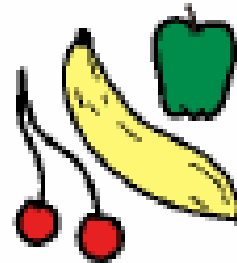
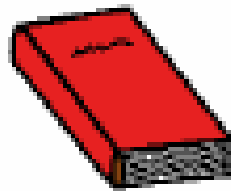

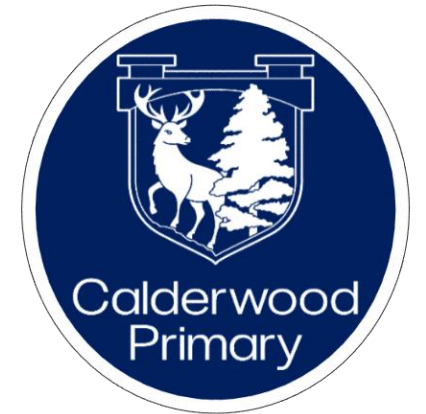
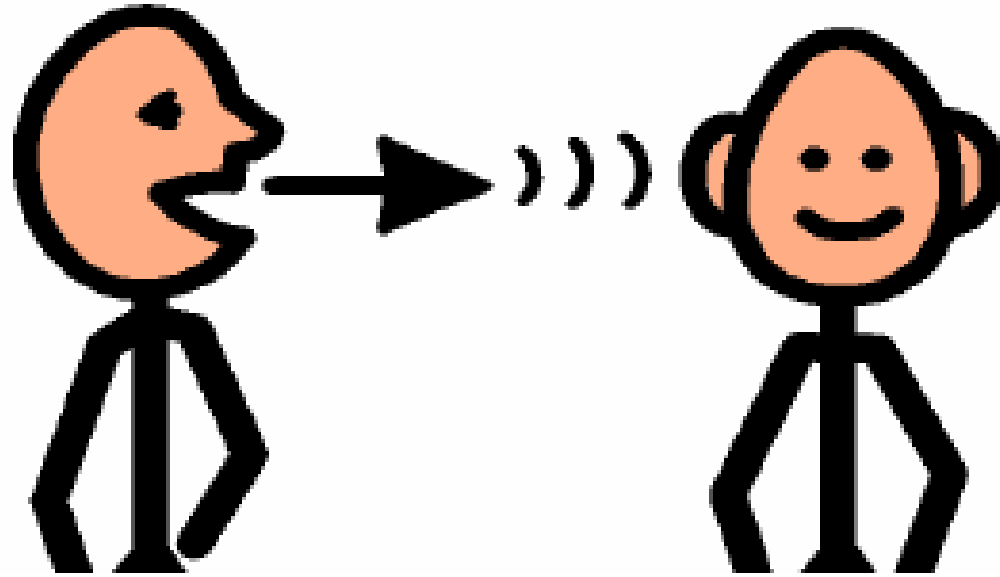


My champion (teacher) is there to help me.
