Include key events from those years, for example music, politics, celebrations and global issues.	Task 4 Design a team game that can be played in or outdoors. Include rules and equipment. When you have designed and planned your game, try it with friends and family.
Task 5 Use online sources to gather information about your favourite music artist or band. Detail the important parts of their life and music career and note this in your Teams notebook.
