This is a small part of a huge campaign to reduce the cost of the school day. We are going to be working alongside the parent council to write our statement and this will be on our website prior to the Easter Holidays. Our pupils have already been part of a survey where they stated that they felt school trips had the biggest impact on the cost of the school day. We have therefore allocated £250 to each class and the children have been busy planning their school trip! This money is from the Pupil Equity Fund (PEF) which is given to us from Scottish Government to support families living in poverty.</p> <p>Suitable clothing: Please can you ensure that your child/ren are coming to school suitably dressed for the changeable weather.
