This morning's literacy challenge as follows (everyone can attempt mild, and if you fancy a challenge you can try Spicy).

<p>Maths Mild</p> <p>Today we are going to be using our fingers to help us count.</p> <p>With a grown-up:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can you count to 10 with your fingers?• Can you tell an adult how many fingers they are holding up?• How about if they use different fingers (e.g thumb and pinkie for 2 instead of thumb and forefinger)• Can you hold up a number of fingers that a grown-up asks you to?	<p>Literacy Mild</p> <p>Looking at f this week, fish are a common theme. Can you sing the rhyme, there are lots of versions on youtube:</p> <p><i>"1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive"</i></p> <p>In class 1 our alphabet is displayed with every letter on an octopus and capitals are on jellyfish. Can you read all of your phonics sounds on the alphabet fish?</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can you hold up the number of fingers an adult asks in a different way?• Can you tell a grown-up the number before or the number after a shown number (this will need shown first)• Can you draw around a grown-ups hand and number each of the fingers. (This may need to be traced (child hands will be a little small).	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can you either draw your own alphabet fish or use the template attached and write in as many letters as you can! This might take a few sessions. (A grown up might need to draw letters to trace, and watch out for colouring over the letters!)
