This morning's literacy and maths challenges are as follows (everyone can attempt mild, and if you fancy a challenge you can try Spicy).

<p>Maths Mild Class 1 enjoy active maths games. 'Hoopla' is a brilliant active maths game. Mr Hunter really wanted to play quoits at Mill Farm with Class 1 (a similar Scottish game that uses horseshoes for hoops) but the trampolines were more exciting. Hoopla is a game that usually works by throwing hoops onto a wooden peg frame for points which can be added up. In most games different pegs of the frame are worth different points but for simplicity I would make every peg worth 1 point.</p>	<p>Literacy Mild Mr Hunter's hippo is not very happy. He is hot and hungry. Can you draw some food for Mr Hunter's hippo? Why would the hippo be hot? Can you draw what you think?  Class 1 love Hungry Hippo's. If you have a copy it would be great fun to play at home during our h week!  If you want to see something really silly try to find some old Disney 'Fantasia' clips where you get to see lots of Hippo's dancing the Ballet!</p>
