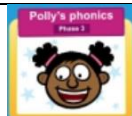

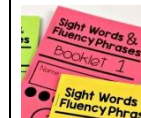


## Tricky Words

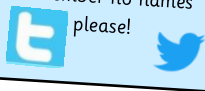
