
## Inky's Vowel House Story



The story, supported by the actions and the window shapes, is used to help your child learn the vowel sounds. Your child is already familiar with the story and may even be able to tell you it using the visual!

Some background information to help understand the visual:

- The window shapes represent the shape of the lips.
- It is helpful if your child has access to a mirror to see the shape of their lips as they make each vowel sound. Point out that the shape of their lips matches the window of the character making that sound.
- Start at the top left window of the house, go down to the basement then back up the right and finally down the middle.
