Submissions are due by Friday 8th May. We can't wait to see them!



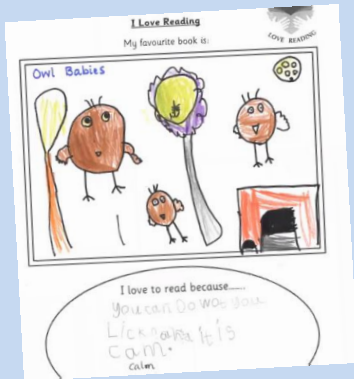
Different Ways to Enter !
