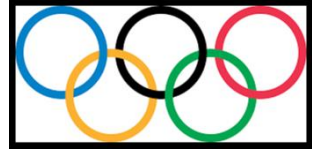




EPS OLYMPIC ACTIVITY GRID 2

Olympic Country Flag

Research the national flag of your chosen country. What colours is it and why was this design chosen?

Once you have researched it draw it, paint it or make a collage with torn up paper.

Extension: Try some flag symmetry.

Olympic Outfits

Design an outfit for your country's athletes to wear at the Opening Ceremony. You can use the colours of your country's flag. Think about any accessories the athletes would need for the Opening Ceremony. You could draw, paint, collage or use material to make your outfits.

Extension: Can you use junk to make an Olympic hat that your countries athletes could wear.

National Anthem

Listen to the National Anthem of your chosen country. Can you sing the it or can you even play it on a musical instrument?

Extension: Does your country have a certain style of dance or music. Find out what you can about it and give it a go.

Crazy Countries

Carry out some crazy country research on your chosen country. Once you have researched your country display your findings in a poster, fact file or using digital learning. Use the supporting sheet for research ideas.

Extension: Can you learn some simple phrases or numbers in the language of your chosen country.

Host City

For each Olympics a different host city is chosen to host the Games. Make a persuasive poster, leaflet or record an advert about why your chosen country should host the next Olympic Games.

Extension: Can you create a model or picture of a famous landmark from your chosen country.

Country Top Trumps

Choose 12 of the Olympic countries and make your own top trumps cards to play. You could include the following: country name, flag, population, number of medals at 2016 Olympics, capital city, size.

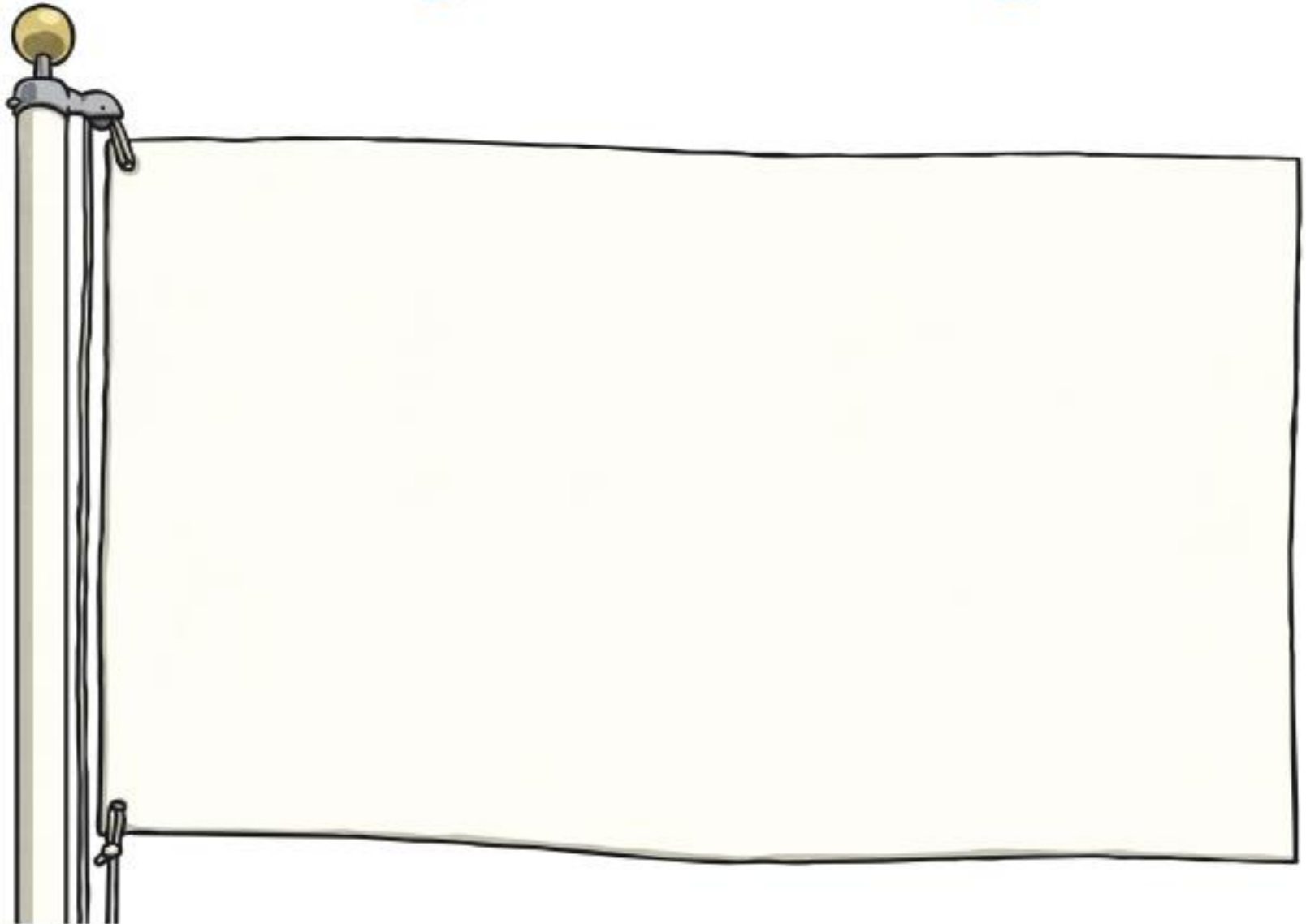
Extension: Can you find out previous host countries and colour them in on the map.

There are more than 80 countries competing in the Winter Olympics. Here are some of the national flags.

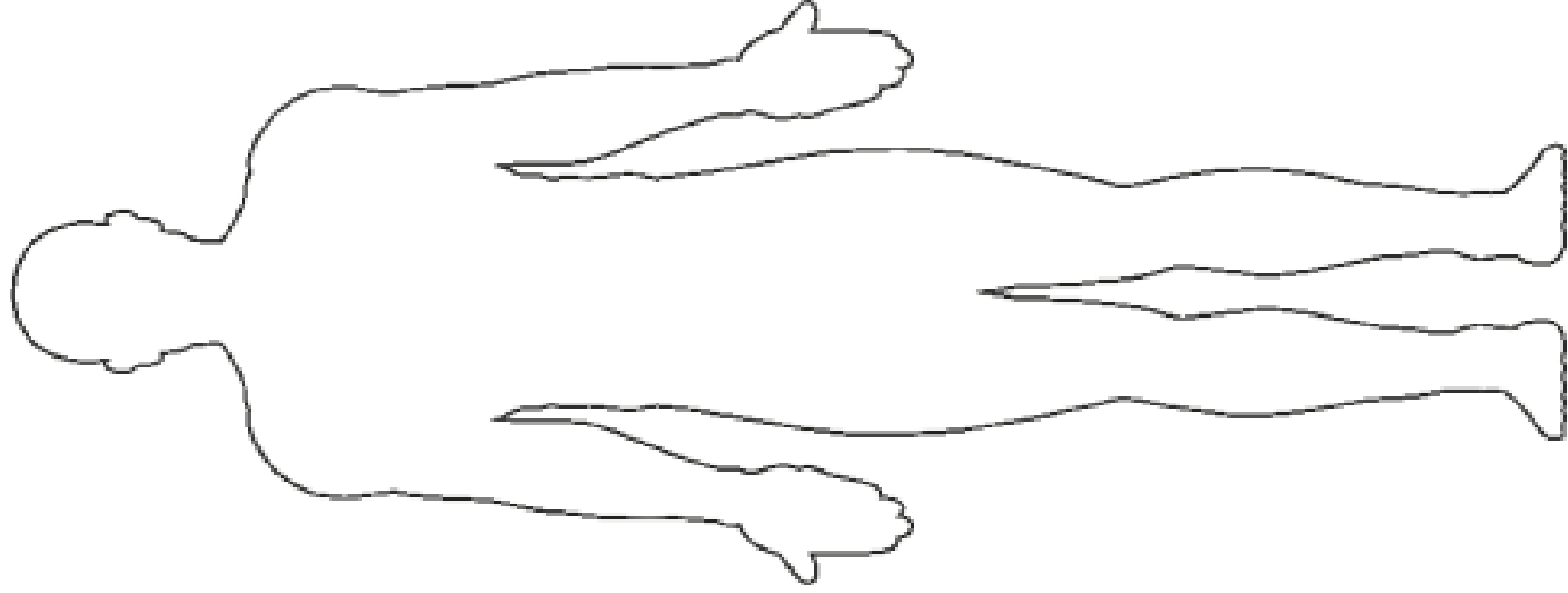
