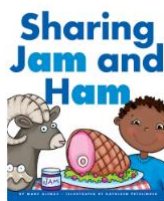

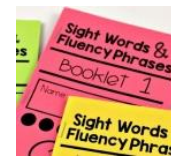


What rhyming words did you hear?

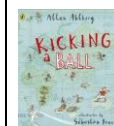

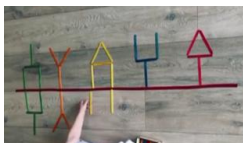
Play 'Chopper Squad' game

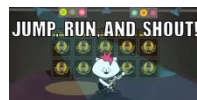
