(Sing to the tune of 'Frère Jacques'/'Are You Sleeping?')

Get your playdough, get your playdough,
Roll a ball, roll a ball.

(Children should roll the playdough between their hands and then stretch their fingers out wide.)

Squash your playdough, squash your playdough,

(Children should squash the playdough between their hands, nip it around the edges and then splat it between both hands.)

Roll your playdough, roll your playdough,
Thin and long, thin and long,

Can you make your fingers, can you make your fingers,
Very strong, very strong?

(Children should roll the playdough between their hands to create a long sausage shape.)

Squeeze your playdough, squeeze your playdough,
That's the way, that's the way.

Pat it with each finger, pat it with each finger,
Playdough play, playdough play!

(Children should squeeze the playdough in one hand and then the other. Then press each finger in turn into the dough.)
