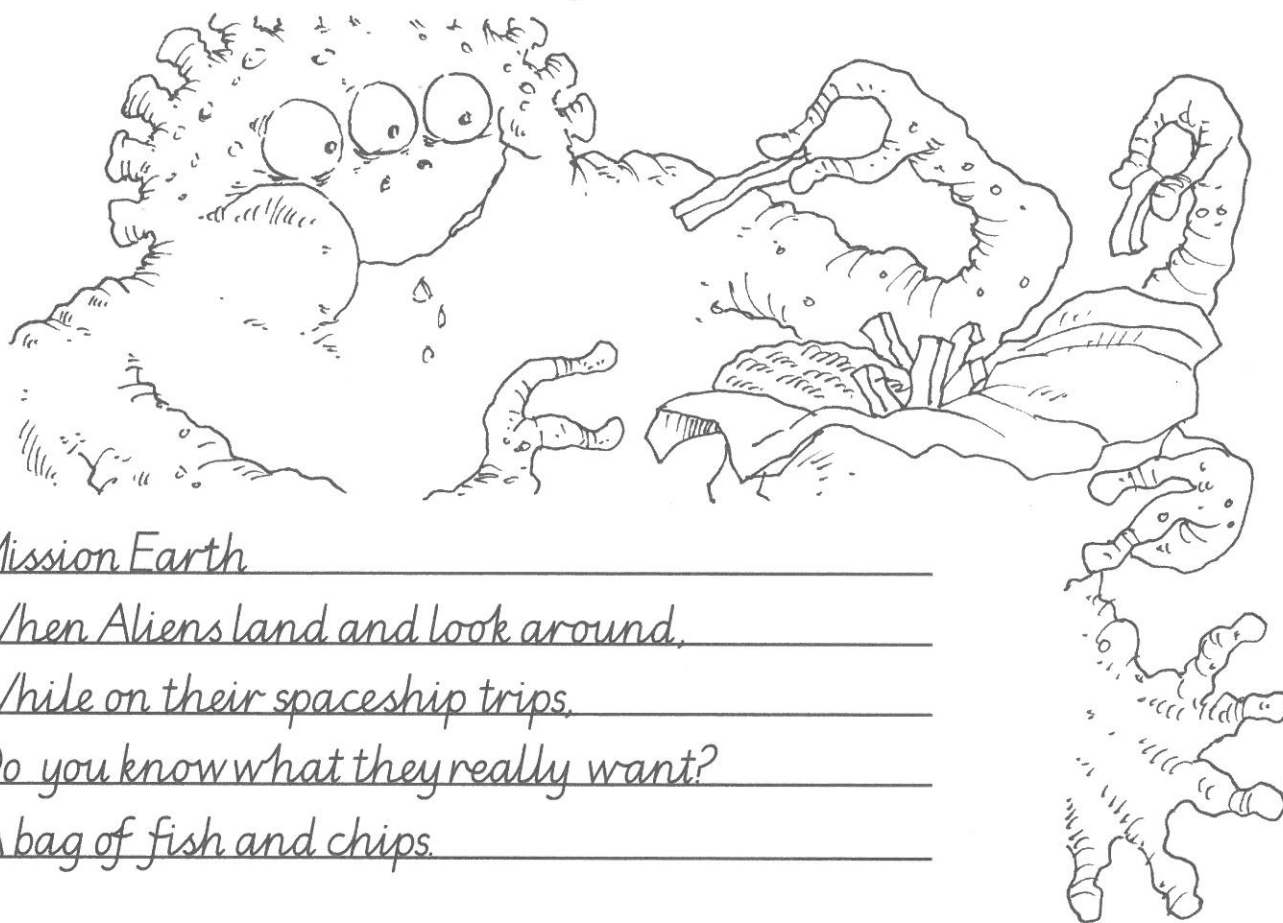


## Extension
