He then uses mind-mapping or (spider diagrams as he calls them) to plan and discuss a range of ideas to help you to come up with a poem using the title: **If All the World Were...**

If All the World Were Sweets

You can use your imagination and the description bubbles we used in the classroom might also help you to plan your poem. Think of your 5 senses and use lots of interesting adjectives to help the reader to use their senses when they are reading your poem.

Joseph talks about all the poetry techniques we used in class when we were writing our poetry for the Young Writer competitions so you should be familiar with them.

You can choose which style of poetry to use and it would be lovely to see some illustrations to go with your poetry.
