Revision (to test your memory!)

So remember way back to Primary 1 and the very first week of Primary 2, we looked at o'clock times.

On an analogue clock (the circle one with the hands), we know it is o'clock when the “**big hand**” - the longer hand **points to the number 12**.

The “**little hand**” – the shorter one, **tells us the hour** it is. So in the following clock:



The big hand is at the 12 (o'clock) and the little hand is pointing to the 8, so the time is 8 o'clock.

This is written as 8:00 or 8.00 in digital time (the hour number coming first then the minutes coming after the colon (:)) or dot (.).

Remember we put **am** if it is in the **morning** i.e. 8:00am is 8 in the morning – breakfast time.

Whereas **pm** means it is **afternoon/evening/night** time so 8:00pm is 8 at night – bedtime!



8. How many Tuesdays are in January?
9. What is the month that comes after January?
10. Which month comes before January?
