- 3. It's time to leave for the Parks. You need to catch the bus from Disney Springs to the Magic Kingdom. How long will your bus journey take?



4. You will now need to buy park tickets for you and your family.

Calculate how much park tickets would cost you. Remember that you might want to buy a weekly pass to allow you enough time to explore!
