## Questions:

1. Which of the 2 shapes shown above are NOT polygons? The circle and semi-circle because they have curved sides.
2. What shape am I? I have 4 straight sides, 2 are long and 2 are short and I have 4 corners. a rectangle
3. What shape am I? I have 1 curved side and no corners. a circle
4. What shape am I? I have 5 straight sides and 5 corners. a pentagon
5. What shape am I? I have one curved side and one straight side. semi-circle
6. What shape am I? I have 3 straight sides and 3 corners. a triangle
7. Can you give a "What shape am I?" description for an octagon? I have 8 straight sides and 8 corners.
8. Which animal, which lives in the ocean, has 8 legs? An octopus. Can you see any connection with the name of one of the shapes? Octagon and octopus - one has 8 sides and 8 corners, the other has 8 legs - octa comes from the Greek and Latin languages and means 8. (October used to be the $8^{\text {th }}$ month in the Roman calendar although it is now the $10^{\text {th }}$ month in our calendar.)
9. What is the next shape in this sequence and why?

goes from a 3 sided triangle, 4 sided square, 5 sided pentagon - so we are adding one more side each time.
10. I noticed that most baths are a sort of rectangle shape. Why do you think designers have made them this way? I think it is because our bodies, when we lie flat, are sort of rectangular, so fit in better than say a triangle shape. Also it is easier to fit a rectangle into a square/rectangular shaped bathroom with straight walls. What did you think?
11. Wheels on bikes, cars, trucks and trains tend to be like circles. Why is this do you think? Circular shapes roll better and smoother.
