


WALT identify and name some 2D shapes. (MTH 1-16a)

2D shape: 2 dimensional – length and width.



I am going to describe a drawing I want you to do. Try and follow the instructions and see what you end up with. You can compare it to my drawing at the end of the week, when I put the answers on the Blog.

- 1. Draw a big yellow rectangle.
- 2. In the middle of the rectangle, draw a small red triangle.
- 3. Below the red triangle but still inside the rectangle, draw a slightly bigger pink octagon.
- 4. Above the red triangle and still inside the yellow rectangle, draw 2 blue semicircles. One of them is above the red triangle and a little to the right. The other blue semi-circle is above the red triangle and a little to the left.
- 5. On top of the yellow rectangle, draw a big green triangle.
- 6. On top of the green triangle, sitting on the top corner, draw a small red circle.

Challenge: Do a drawing using 2D shapes then describe it to someone else and see if they can draw it. Compare pictures afterwards.
