# Learning Overview – Primary 6/5



The focus for this term will be:

## Literacy and English

### Reading

- Continue our group reading
- Our class novel will be 'Fir for Luck' which is based on the events of the Highland Clearances
- We will be exploring different types of poems in our Reflective Reading sessions to develop our ability to identify poetic techniques

### Writing

- Focus on **Poetry** and **Recount** writing
- Poetry – Looking at different poetic techniques such as similes and metaphors, alliteration and personification.
- Recount – Looking at an ability to recall events and occasions in our own lives using who, what, where, why and when to add lots of detail. We will also be thinking about the lives of people in the Highland Clearances and try to recount what might have happened to them and how they felt.

- Reading with expression
