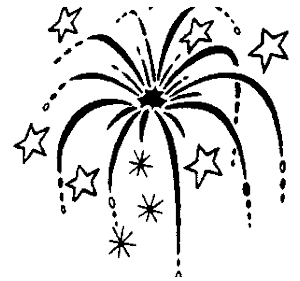




Kirkhill Nursery Newsletter

We would like to extend a warm welcome to all our new children and their families who have joined us this term. If you have any questions or queries please do not hesitate to speak to our nursery team.

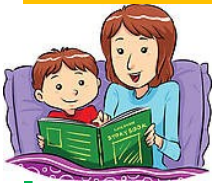
