LITERACY TIPS!

When writing: How we do it in class -

- 1. Miss Brown asks what the children wants to write and supports them to come up with a sentence.
- 2. First always draw a picture to plan writing and then write underneath.
- 3. Miss Brown supports you by saying the words sometimes but children sound out on their own.
- 4. You should sound out your words how you think they sound. (example, the word eat children may spell as eet which is very good)
- 5. Miss Brown would remind children of finger spaces and full stops.

Mild, Spicy and Hot activities

 Children should choose at least 1 task Mild, Spicy or Hot but may choose more.

Each task is different and the spicier they choose the more challenging the tasks get. Children should be encouraged to challenge themselves and to pick a task that is challenging to them.

If the child feels it is too easy then moving to a hotter spice task will be great.

If not sure start on the Spicy and see how your child
