



## LITERACY

## NUMERACY

We are all at slightly different points in our time work now so if you have pages left in your booklet keep going, doing a little bit every day.

Lets try some fact families today. Remember you can only use the three numbers in the line and need two adding and two take away questions each time. So for example: 5 and 2 make 7

$$5+2=7, 2+5 =7, 7-5=2, 7-2=5$$

Use your number cards to choose two numbers and add them together to find the third number in your group. Try to do 5 different groups of numbers. To make it harder make one of the numbers 2 digits for example  $24 + 3 = 27$ ,  $3 +24 =27$ ,  $27 - 24 = 3$ ,  $27 - 3 =24$ .
