TOPIC – Looking to the past

Today we are going to continue learning about the history of toys. Yesterday we learned about the oldest cuddly toy and today we are going to learn about dolls houses.

The first dolls house was made in Germany in 1558! This means people have been making dolls houses for around 500 years. They used to be for adults to show how much money they had because it was expensive to have all the tiny items. There are even doll houses with running water and electric lights. They have only been popular for children for around forty years.
