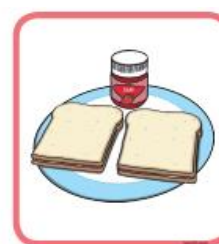
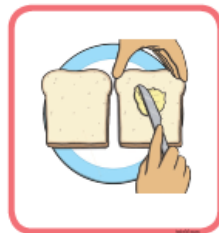
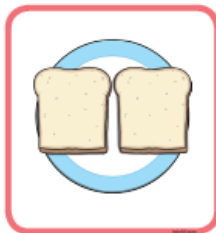
Today we are going to start off by looking at making a jam sandwich. Start by listing some of the things you may need such as jam. Think about what you would do **first, then, next, finally**.

Here are some pictures to help you write your steps 😊 (Maybe you might even have a jam sandwich for lunch – let me know how you get on!)

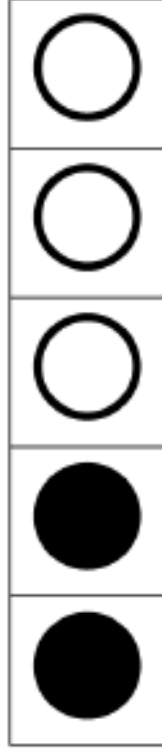
