I have been thinking and if you want you can use the comic template in your pack then you can or you can draw four to six boxes in your jotter which I think might be better.

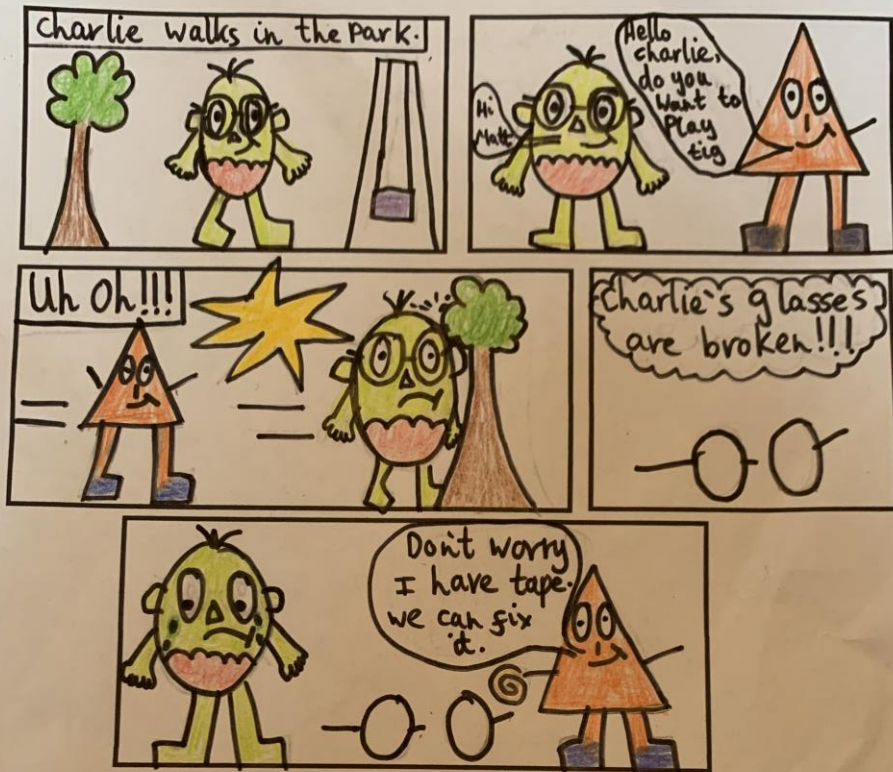
Introduce your character	What and where is your character?
