### Practical Maths

Learning Intention – I can explore and learn about **Time** and discover a variety of different items which help us to tell the Time.

- Read the information on each slide and share your answers with your family as you read each question
- Look around your home and make a list of the different objects you have to help you tell the time
- Can you find some of the **objects** which you saw in the powerpoint?
- Now try this Time activity **outside**
- Use **chalks** to make the numbers on your clock face around the circle as the picture shows on the next page
- Find sticks, rulers or your own ideas to show the hour hand and the minute hand and remember to make one shorter than the other
- Use your clock to show different times related to **O'clock, Half Past, Quarter Past and Quarter to**

- For example – 3 o'clock, Half past 4, Quarter Past 8 and Quarter to 10
- Play a guessing game with a grown up to work out the times you make on the clock

## Literacy

### Using A or An in Front of Words

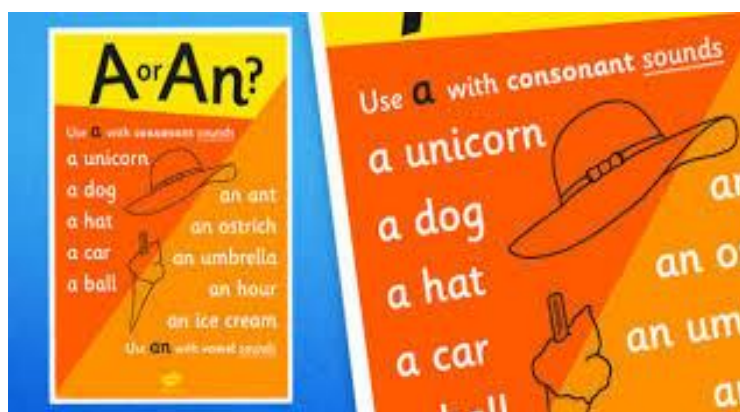
Learning Intention – I can learn to understand and recognise when to use a or an in front of a word which is a noun. A noun in the name of an object or a person.

There are 5 letters which we call vowels. These are a, e, i, o and u.

We use the letter a in front of a word beginning with a vowel.

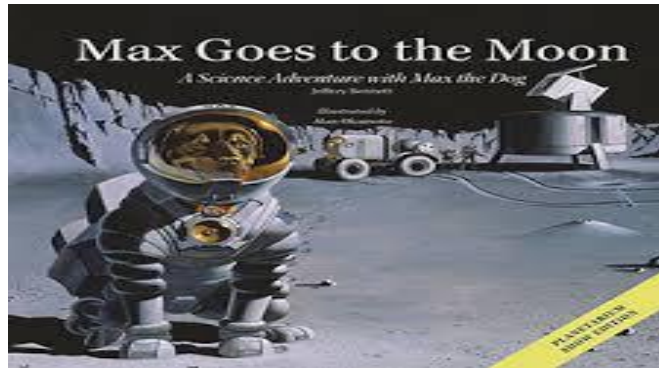
The rest of our letters are called consonants. We use an in front of a word beginning with a consonant.

a toy   a plant   a window   an orange   an umbrella   an elephant
