Literacy

- Continuing to focus on punctuation when writing.
- Continuing to develop fluency, expression and comprehension skills in reading.
- Practising forming upper and lower case letters correctly.
- Identify punctuation and changes in text and how this changes our understanding in reading.
- Writing a recollection piece about our visit to the farm.
