I have enjoyed watching a great movie called Zombie's on Disney+. It is a bit of a musical and I have also enjoyed watching and listening to their songs on You tube.

I have enjoyed drawing and my mum, and I have started a paint by numbers tiger and cub drawing which will look great when it is finished.

During school time I have enjoyed playing Sumdog and I am trying really to be top of the leader board. I have found some pieces of work easy and others challenging. I have enjoyed reading the book Millions and I read it to my mum who is also enjoying the story. The best bit about school is a Friday when all of us have a chat.

During Lockdown I have really enjoyed having all the amazing food my mum and dad have been making. I have enjoyed being able to eat my breakfast without having to rush to get ready for school.
