

# Livingston Village Primary School - Window into Learning

Term: August to October 2021

## Literacy

This term in literacy, P3 will:

- Begin working towards the identified P3 Core Writing Targets
- Explore different aspects of grammar and implement them in our writing
- Receive weekly reading books tailored to continually develop overall reading and comprehension ability
- Produce a piece of descriptive writing around our IDL topic of the 20 year project
- Produce a narrative piece of writing
- Continue to develop fluency and expression within reading
- Answer and understand comprehension questions following reading
- Consolidate forming upper and lower case letters correctly

## Numeracy

This term in numeracy P3 will:

- Continue to develop their ability to use a range of mental maths (+ & -) strategies, such as: counting on; counting back and partitioning. This will be reinforced through Number Talks.
- Extend and consolidate their knowledge of place value and number sequences by: reading, recording and ordering numbers to 1000; exploring digits up to and then beyond 1000; establishing the value of the digits within a number by identifying which digit stands for units, tens, hundreds or thousands using a place value frame; pictorially representing numbers to 1000 using resources such as Base 10.
- Develop their ability to effectively use a 100 square and recognise patterns within these.
- Further explore time, both analogue and digital, and extend knowledge to 15 minute increments.

## Health & Wellbeing

This term in HWB P3 will focus on:

- Developing their ability to openly share their feelings within trusted relationships and safe spaces
- Identifying strategies that can be used to help regulate emotions
- Strengthening their awareness of friendship and the ways in which this can be supported both within and outside the classroom
- Developing a Growth Mindset, with a positive and resilient attitude to challenge (enhanced through the school Resilience programme)
- Establishing a Class Charter and positive classroom ethos
- Fitness, large ball skills and invasive games within P.E.
- Outdoor learning opportunities where possible

## Inter Disciplinary Learning

This term our IDL will focus on:

- Our topic for the beginning of term is around the subject of 20 years, as LVPS celebrates its 20<sup>th</sup> birthday
- Taking part in 20 year birthday celebrations
- Looking into the past and investigating similarities and differences within the past 20 years
- Creating innovative models for the 20 year project, using our group work skills
- Showcasing finished products through presentation of ideas and features of models
- Pupil's Choice - P3 will choose our interdisciplinary topic for the remainder of this term
