Literacy

This term in literacy, P3 will:

- Continue working towards the identified P3 Core Writing Targets
- Explore different aspects of grammar and implement them in our writing
- Receive weekly reading books tailored to continually develop overall reading and comprehension ability
- Produce a piece of recount writing around an event that has happened recently
- Enjoy opportunities to free write
- Continue to develop fluency and expression within reading
- Answer and understand comprehension questions
- Learn about comprehension strategies to understand what we are reading. Focus this term on prediction and inference
- Continue to develop handwriting

Numeracy

This term in numeracy P3 will:

- Continue to develop their ability to use a range of mental maths (+ & -) strategies, such as: counting on; counting back and partitioning. This will be reinforced through Number Talks.
- Explore pictorial representations of times tables through strategies such as arrays and groups.
- Develop understanding of times tables through repeated addition.
- Develop understanding of division and how this relates to multiplication
- Further explore time, both analogue and digital, in 15 minute increments
- Develop understanding of money and how it is used using coins and notes

Health & Wellbeing

This term in HWB P3 will focus on:

- Continuing to develop their ability to openly share their feelings within trusted relationships and safe spaces
 - Identifying strategies that can be used to help regulate emotions
 - Strengthening their awareness of friendship and the ways in which this can be supported both within and outside the classroom
 - Developing a Growth Mindset, with a positive and resilient attitude to challenge (enhanced through the school Resilience programme)
- Using the Class Charter and positive classroom ethos in everyday learning
- Learning benchball, football and social dance skills in P.E.
 - Outdoor learning opportunities where possible

Inter Disciplinary Learning

This term our IDL will focus on:

- Learning about space. Using the questions and ideas that P3 shared in a mind map, that they would like to learn about and exploring the subject.
- Taking part in singing and music celebrations in the lead up to Christmas
- Enjoying Christmas celebrations in school
