

# *Livingston Village Primary School - Window into Learning*

*Term: 3 - January to March 2022*

## ***Literacy***

This term in literacy, P3 will:

- Continue working towards the identified P3 Core Writing Targets
- Explore different aspects of grammar and implement them in our writing
- Receive weekly reading books tailored to continually develop overall reading and comprehension ability
- Develop and produce a writing piece based on creating own Scottish mythical creature. Class visit to The Kelpies to support planning and development
- Produce a piece of information report writing
- Enjoy opportunities to free write
- Continue to develop fluency and expression within reading
- Learn about comprehension strategies to understand what we are reading. Focus this term on inference and questioning

## ***Numeracy***

This term in numeracy P3 will:

- Continue to develop a range of mental maths (+ & -) strategies, such as: counting on; counting back and partitioning. This will be reinforced through Number Talks
- Explore pictorial representations of times tables through strategies such as arrays and groups
- Develop understanding of times tables through repeated addition
- Develop understanding of division and how this relates to multiplication
- In Maths, we will be learning about statistics and properties of shape
- Recapping in previous learning of time and money

## ***Health & Wellbeing***

This term in HWB P3 will focus on:

- Continuing to develop their ability to openly share their feelings within trusted relationships and safe spaces
- Identifying strategies that can be used to help regulate emotions
- Strengthening their awareness of friendship and the ways in which this can be supported both within and outside the classroom
- Developing a Growth Mindset, with a positive and resilient attitude to challenge (enhanced through the school Resilience programme)
- Using the Class Charter and positive classroom ethos in everyday learning
- Learning gymnastics and badminton skills in P.E.
- Making birdfeeders in outdoor learning
- Outdoor learning opportunities where possible

## ***Inter Disciplinary Learning***

This term our IDL will focus on:

- Scottish focus in January including class assembly on Scots language. Performance live in school for rest of school via Teams
- As per class feedback, rest of term will focus on the Egyptians
- Taking part in singing and performing for assembly
- Using digital skills developed in learning and using these skills across the curriculum
- In Art, we will be creating sculptures for writing project to represent own Scottish mythical creature
