(no internet help please!)

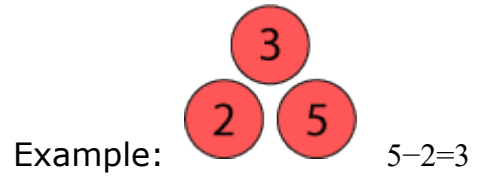
Cook or bake something for your family. Make sure you have an adults permission and help.
