We're pleased to say that schools can already access all of our fantastic teacher and student resources and tools on tablets and mobile devices via ***Puffin Academy***, an app that is free to download via the iTunes and Android stores.



Puffin Academy is a 'Mobile Flash Browser' for pupils, teachers, and parents and always enforces site filtering by only allowing whitelisted educational websites to be accessed. Once you have downloaded the app search on it for *Education City* and install. Then login and play. Please see the '***How to install Puffin Academy***' link for instructions.

We're also working hard to be mobile-ready in our own right by converting some of our most valued Flash-based content to HTML5 making EducationCity even more accessible via mobile devices. This is an ongoing project and we hope to share the first batch with you soon. Keep an eye on our blog for updates.
